Police Continue to Search for Missing 15 year old Pregnant Female

Approximately one week ago, New Castle County Detectives released information regarding a missing teenage pregnant female who disappeared from her home after leaving school early. Investigators have since received no confirmed sightings or information regarding her whereabouts from the media or public.

Janteyl Johnson, a resident of the unit block of Winterhaven Drive in the Autumn Park Apartments, was last seen after she left school early on February 3rd and has not been seen or heard from since.

On Wednesday (2/3) at 10:00 p.m., County Police responded to Johnson's residence after her mother called 911 to report her daughter was missing from the home. After learning the victim had disappeared and not called any of her family and friends, investigators completed a missing person report. They later had an automated alert system (A Child is Missing) notifying the surrounding communities of the search for the teen.

Johnson was last seen wearing a black ski jacket with fur around the hood. She is 5'2", 120 pounds, and has long braided black hair. To offer information regarding her whereabouts, please contact the New Castle County Police Department at 395-8110 attention Detective Seth Polk.
