HPRP Activity Funding Ranking Sheet

The City of Wilmington requests your assistance in ranking and prioritizing the following eligible activities as areas of need where our Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) funds can best be utilized. (Ranking: 1 – 12, with 1 being the greatest area of need and 12 the least.)

Financial assistance

- ___ Short-term rental assistance (3 months)
- ___ Medium-term rental assistance (4 – 18 months)
- ___ Rental arrears or to remain in a housing unit or move to another unit
- ___ Security and utility deposits
- ___ Utility payments – (up to 18 months, including up to 6 months of arrears)
- ___ Moving assistance costs – (a maximum of 3 months)
- ___ Hotel and motel vouchers – (up to 30 days)

Housing relocation and stabilization services

- ___ Case management
- ___ Outreach and engagement – (marketing/publicizing of the program)
- ___ Housing search and placement
- ___ Legal services
- ___ Credit repair

Data collection and evaluation

Appropriate funding will be set aside for the data collection to cover reasonable and appropriate costs associated our Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) for purposes of collecting and reporting data required under HPRP.

Administrative costs

Up to 5 percent cap of the City's HPRP grant may be spent on administrative costs. The City is required to shall share a reasonable and appropriate amount of administrative funds with subgrantees.
