

COMPUTERIZED MOBILE DATA TERMINALS

Directive: 6.76

A. Policy

The purpose of this policy is to give personnel a guideline for the use of Computerized Mobile Data Terminals while conducting police functions.

B. Equipment

The Wilmington Department of Police is currently uses [REDACTED] laptop computers for departmental vehicles. These computers are connected to the Delaware State Law Enforcement Network [REDACTED]

Each computer has installed software that allows access to [REDACTED] information and the Law Enforcement Investigative Support System. The software packages allow officers to access law enforcement information from their vehicles and the ability to complete police reports electronically.

C. Care and Maintenance

An inspection of the unit should be completed prior to going into service. Any damage to the unit will be reported to the officer's immediate supervisor prior to going into service. A Departmental Information report will be submitted detailing the damage and a copy will be forwarded to the Technology Unit of the Communications Division.

Under no circumstances will officers change any settings, add additional software, or alter the current software running on agency-owned mobile data terminals.

D. Training

The Technology Unit of the Communications Division will conduct updated training pertaining to the Computerized Mobile Data Terminals.
