Vacuum Sweep Collection October 19 — December 31

- Large piles of leaves should be swept into the street, next to the curb.
- City sweeper or vacuum trucks will collect the leaves from the street.
- When possible, street cleaning will post signage the day before for large volume leaf pick-up.

Private Contractors

If you use a private contractor to remove leaves from your property, please coordinate your leaf removal in accordance with this schedule, or have your contractor bag your leaves in brown PAPER BAGS and place at the curb for pick-up on Wednesdays.

Holidays

If a collection day falls on a holiday, pick-up will occur on the next leaf collection day.

Year-Round Yardwaste Curbside Collection Reminder

All leaves and yardwaste should be placed in brown PAPER BAGS and placed next to the curb for pick-up on Wednesdays.
